1. Redemption-God removes that which separates man from Himself. The Soul

"Buy back a slave or captive, making him free by payment of a ransom.

This means that man was in the power of sin, the grip, the dominion of sin, and that Jesus alone can free him from it.

Our justification depends on the fact that God has intervened to emancipate His people from bondage to sin.

The blood of Christ was the channel through which God's grace saved us. His life was the ransom, His blood the price.

2. Propitiation- A means of turning away the wrath of God.
The mercy-seat that covered the ark--where blood was shed,
where God met man in mercy.

"Set forth-" Placed him before the eyes of all, once and for all, never to be repeated.

Redemption contemplates our bondage to sin and is the provision of grace to release us from that bondage. Propitiation contemplates our liability to the wrath of God and is the provision of grace whereby we may be freed from that wrath.

The grace of God operates through the sacrifice of Jesus--this is why He must be the object of our faith.
