## BAPTISM OF THE SPIRIT

## I. TWO BASIC SCHOOLS OF BELIEF

- 1. Those who believe it is an act subsequent to and in addition to salvation for power in service, etc.
  - 2. Those who believe it is a work done in xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx every believer at the moment of salvation.

We are never commanded to be baptized with the Spirit, nor told to seek or pray for it.

- II. WHAT IS THE BAPTISM OF THE SPIRIT? I Cor. 12:\3 is our text
- 1. It occurs to ALL believers
  - (1) I Cor 12:3 ALL had be baptized.
  - (2) Eph. 4:5
  - (3) We are never commanded to be baptized with Spirit
- 2. IT Occurs att eh moment of Conversion. Every conversion is a Pentecpst in effect, when the Spirit comes to indwell the believer.
- I Cr. 12:73 We are made members of his body. See Acts 2 where the "Lord added to the church..."

It unifies us with Christ, makes us ONE with Him. Rom. 6:2ff

- 3. IT IS A NONEXPERIENTIAL WORK. This isn't based upon or derived from experience; it happens whether or not we're conscious of it.
- 4. The Baptism doesn't have to do with a special enduement of Power. xxxxx Tongues were never given as a sign to fulness of Spirit but of conversion. Acts 10 & 19.
