All perfection consists in doing God's will. The works which seem great are nothing if not God's will (Matt. 7:21).

A knowledge of God's will and being filled with it precede a life pleasing to Him.

To be filled with such knowledge is to have it pervading our houghts, etc.

Paul prays that they may attain to the full knowledge of God's will through the insight that His Spirit imparts, and thus be able to please Him in everything....in this epistle Paul has much to say about knwledge promoting the Christian life v. 10. "Growing by the knowledge of God." Cf. 1:28 "teaching every man in all wisdom that we may present every man perfect in KKKKKX Christ Jesus."

4:12 - Their spiritual experience will be filled out to completeness through their knowledge and performance of the complete will of mGod. Chrysostom: "It is not enough, simply, to do His will. He that is filled suffereth not any knieux other will to be within him, for if so, he is not wholly filled."

1:9, FILLED suggests the idea of filling out to completeness. Such knowledge is not the product of fleshlt wisdom of the world. It comes from the illumination of the Holy Spirit. He is is who gives that wisdom and understanding which enables us to know the will of God.

WISDOM: that THINKING that is controlled and enlightened by the Holy Spirit.

UNDERSTANDING: speaks of the apllication of this basic wisdom to the various problems which present themselves and require a clear analysis before a decisoon can be made.
