flood shed - 2. Precious blood - 6 Costly = like a
ransom - not a 10-mercant salvation 2. Highly honored
- Bankrupt heaven - Offensive = Offense of The
Cross = Church growth - say nothing that makes
them uncomfortable - Johnath Edwards

II. a Vicarious Death - 1. Isaiah = isa 53:7

1. Innocent a - w/out inherent flaw b - w/out
~~eternal~~ eternal defilement 2. Sacrificial, Substitution
"I remembered you at Calvary" 3 - an act of worship
"O's finest hour." 4 Weakness = lamb = O
saved us by His Weakness.

2. Foreknown from Foundation of World: Perf. Part

O = Redeemer first, the Creator = 1 X's sacrifice
is seen as eternally present = why O.T. people could be
saved. 2 not "Plan B".

2) Salvator. so glorious = O deemed it better to
create & redeem, than not create
