

1 Peter 3:1-4. Bible gets around to saying something about wrong way. Peter starts in heaven, winds up in hatcher. Many in Church, but many more outside Church

- 1. The attraction/saved wives, lost husbands.
- 2. Why is this so? O wife more tender & responsive
- 3. Less careful Paul: "woman decided first,"
Bible clearly forbids xians to enter relationships w/ unbelievers. Paul: "widows marry again in the Lord." "Can two walk together unless they agree?"
"when children want to stay home w/ Daddy"

- 4. Can get a new husband - Acts 16:31 - wife has way reason to cherish hope for sal. of unbelieving husband.
Some don't want husbands saved - I'll at valley view - just wanted him to stop drinking
"w/out word" = don't nag "I'm not a deserter, I'm a refugee" - a woman has good horse sense, she'll never become a nag.

- 3. Posture A - Submission: Plainly says I could use this in winning them ^{not of fear, but love}
B - Pure behavior - fear of doing anger to hurt testimony. ^{selflessness}
C - meek & gentle spirit = disposition

Peter's advice: He tells her nothing else than to be a good wife

adornings = give us much time to decorating life & show x as bodies to show style

Life governed by new set of standards.

- Confronting him w/ the world instead of Savior
- image of man is ideal medium thru which x reveals himself, but of world, imperfect medium & beauty of Jesus hidden beneath veneer of worldliness.
