I Chron 32: 1ff

Intro. - it is one of the great puzzles of Bible how good can come to be troubled.

~~¶~~ V. 1 - a surprise - after all these acts of faithfulness then came a blessing but battle = Jesus always comes in form of another

Hes. a mirror reflects the experience in all ages as a revelation of a great law & process of Divine Working

I Blessing does not Lift us Above the Human

Situation - not immune from human weakness - we are still subject to the ordinary contingencies of life
— the Natural law is God's law

I Blessing Brings at Form of Trial & Trouble

I Kings 18:7 - if you provoke the enemy, he will retaliate — beatitude = the ~~bad~~ world will persecute this kindly person.

Jesus at birth / Moses = The mighty operations of Spirit always uncover & draw forth into the open the antagonism of natural & carnal mind

III Blessing Equips us Battle & Better Blessing

- 1- Delivers us from resting on Past Blessings,
Keeps us from getting lazy & presumption
32: 2-8 - Stirs to energy & activity.
- 2- Drives us to a greater dependence upon
God - v. 20 ; prayer v. 7,8
Anything that makes us pray is a blessing
- 3- Draws ~~us~~ us into a deeper experience of
God's favor & grace v.v. 22,23
