

- 1- She laid him on the prophet's bed -
 - ① - no preparation for funeral
 - ② - in prophet's room - man of G
 - ① placed him before G
 - ② she knew prophet would come
2. She didn't tell her husband
 - ① faith he would be alive
 - ② Husband might not share her faith, might not let her go.
3. She asked her husband's permission -
- in context of faith still obeyed in the small, daily affairs of life.
4. Her answer to husband - "It will be well" Peace
5. Her answer to Gehaze -
"It is well"
6. Her plea = not raise my boy - she reminded him of his words, + promise -
"For the boy to remain dead would be a greater mockery."
7. When Elisha sent servant away, she refused to leave without Elisha!
She knew before Elisha did that the staff wouldn't work -
= she didn't yield to accept less than what G had promised = Elisha
