v. 7 - "Why persecuted thou me? ^{in w/ me but} ^{But really} ^{w/ yourself}

- all his past attitudes & actions -
Notice it was Xians he was persecuting, yet Jesus said, "why do you persecute ME?"
all our sin against Jesus.

26:14 - "It's hurting you instead of me."
1- acts against ^{Heaven} ^{Self} - Prodigal son
2- acts ^{for} ^{me} - Identifies

v. 8 - "Who art thou, lord?" - settled
The question of who Jesus is. The issue of recognition of who HS LS is settled here.

v. 10 - "What shall I do, lord?" - Consecration
- Submission

Obedience w/ this knowledge
(2) Submission - Direction -
