Reactions to Jesus = type of man either for or against - need no surveyors to tell which side of fence in - John: Preacher, "what do you believe?" men are always found in one of these groups in regard to Jesus.

I - Hated & Hostile = Herod. Why? afraid & interfere my life, power, position? There are those who would gladly destroy Jesus because he wants to interfere with life. (3) Klein is a man who censers doing what he likes & does as he likes <sup>either against me or for me.</sup>

→ II Herod the King - or usurping - didn't belong there - no right -

(3) Herod's efforts foolish - if not messiah, he had nothing to fear; if he was, his efforts futile - we also foolish -

II - complete indifference - Scribes. Didn't make slightest difference to them. So engrossed in religion, temple worship, disregarded Jesus - (2) Too busy, too tied up in own affairs - "Is it nothing to you?"

(3) Lost the wonder - so close, couldn't see.

Mary Smith - d. 87 - "born in freedom, don't put in flower pot," Learn to sing from dysphagia, want to sing from heart. (3) Asked secret of freshness - "I never lost the wonder," (B) as a child - at 5 all questions, at 18 all answers - "To be soon old & too late smart,"

(3) nothing is as boring & tiresome as religion w/out the wonder - Pray for rain & don't carry an umbrella - we are weary in well-doing - stand amazed, sit unmoved.

III - Adoring Worship - 3 magi-wisemen - The Gentiles say & exhort to worship King of Israel - but Israel unconverted - a prelude of his rejection & theirs - to the Gentiles.

Three gifts -

- 1 - Gold = for a King - Reign not by force, but love, not from Throne, but Cross.
- ② Jesus is King = must meet Him on terms of complete surrender - Self-Nelson - "First your sword, then hand"
- 2 - Frankincense = gift for priest = nard in temple worship sacrifices - He was a sweet-smelling sacrifice to God - ~~intercessor~~ Intercessor for sinners.
- 3 - Myrrh, gift you me who is to die - embalm bodies - Jesus came to die.
