A Worthy Life - outward conduct consistent w/ inner character

- habitual, continual \circlearrowright Corresponds to what & how done for us \circlearrowleft live in realization that we have a Master, + a greater purpose \circlearrowright His character becomes our standard See Steve & Seminary grades

For this cause - no satisfying of grace

I. The Fountain - v. 9 - all perfection consists in doing O's will - whole passage centers around this - the stress on O's will - "a deep & accurate comprehension" - Here: - "the moral aspect of O's will - His intention for the conduct of our lives"

3. Filled - to provide our being - nothing less or short, nor for nothing else

II. The Flow - "unto all pleasing" - How this pleasing manifests itself, - anticipate

III. The Fulness - 4 Greek Participle following

1. Fruitful in all good works - knowledge leads to O Continual \circlearrowright Comprehensive - one ^{Action} can compensate for another

2. Increasing in knowledge of O = obedience to present revelation condition for additional revelation = Progress, Growth is law of Christian Life

3. Strengthened by Power - Continual
