It is dangerous to forget = Deut: Closing messages
of Moses to his People - may the most impressive notes
is his anxiety that the people should remember -
recognized the influence of memory = proper stored is
a perpetual inspiration = directly memory back to
supreme matters

Remember = to mark = marking a chart or
underlining passages in a book.

what? = led in wilderness = see camp now in wilderness
back & forth, haphazard search, wandering = not so -
I was always before them chose place to camp.
Look back in our life - this year; if you saved, He's
guiding you

His Love in time past
forbids me to think
He'll leave me at last
In trouble to sink

Why? = 3 reasons

I - To Empty us - y pride. Teaches us Dependence

God's toughest task - a teachable spirit = new convert
knows more than poster. Don't for 3rd time will let stronger soul

God's method (1) makes us Hungry (2) Feeds us
(3) From unknown sources - "That's not the way I'd
done it!"
God makes us cry "I'm hungry"

II - To Examine us - teaches us our own

wickedness = doesn't mean that God needs to find out
what is in us; but He wants us to find out what
is in we are in ourselves - God brings us into
circumstances which will reveal the hidden facts
of our nature to ourselves = 2nd Simon Peter = deny

- Even when I preach, there may be playacting in my
nature, God will lead me on a path where it will
come to light.

- Leads us into circumstances that manifest our
hidden faults

III - To Educate us - teach us the
true values of life - Oh, how we need this,
and slow to learn "man doesn't live
by bread alone" - Spiritual greater than
physical - Eternal over temporal
