## 2. Walk In Harmony - vs 3-6

"endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace"

vs 6 = ① "one God & Father of all, --- in you all."

↓ the source, life of the unity

Eph 4:16 - unto all of you - "Soldier, either change your name or your conduct" Walk Worthy - ①

① live kind of life that corresponds to what God has done for us - exhibits transforming grace of God

② life regulated by so realization we belong to God

③ His character is to be our standard.

I Walk In Humility - vs 2 (Beaucher didn't consider these virtues)

1- lowliness - humility of mind = self-evaluation - attitude toward self. ① comes from self-knowledge

② set your life beside life & demands X

2- meekness = used to describe a wild horse that had been tamed - horse still had all of its old power & fire & determination - surrendered power, obedient power under control, discipline controlled by God not feelings

3- long suffering = patience w/ men - bears long w/out striking back in revenge - patient w/ others weaknesses used often by God

④ forbear - endure in love, explains long-suffering fills w/ spirit, express his nature

II - Walk In Harmony - vs 3 1/2

1- the Spirit produces this unity - vs 3 ① the nature of unity = not union - not external, ecclesiastical union - heart unity - fellowship -

② Product of Spirit's work in our hearts - can't be legislated born into a family, w/ family obligations

③ the Saints Preserve this unity - vs 3 - we have a responsibility - ① to keep maintain - means to cherish, guard carefully - present tense

② Endeavoring = our word "speed" - a burning eagerness, blazing zeal in doing this - an inward effort.

How Preserve? By living vs 2 -

- Walk in Holiness vs 17 1/2 - Two inseparable acts -

Put off = taking off dirty clothes  
Put on = Holiness is both negative & positive Praxis - myra 1/2 vs 2
