and His will for us

Absolute & appropriate

① Because no person makes the partner - not just power to serve
② Because the spirit controls the self - but deadly living

I - Command - Imperative = not optional equipment, not
just an item ③ - Be not Drunk by wine - a Sin not to be filled
④ Plural & all on TV to be filled - acts teaches us this over
normal experience - acts 2 - "all" acts 4-5, 100s filled
acts 6 - Deacons commanded to be filled

acts 7:55
acts 11:13 - New converts filled

⑤ Fathers to be filled to resist Old will for us - 6:17
Why & Command? - Not power for service but deadly living
1 - only as Spirit fills us can He accomplish all w/in us
regeneration, sealing, indwelling not enough - Corinthians, Galatians
In Eph 1, 2, 3, 4 Speaks of all spirit has done, yet commands
us to be filled.

2 - God more interested in sort than size - Romans 8:8 -
(Cor 3 - Two Sort of work - Fathers & Sons)

II - Command to Be Controlled - Passive "let ... fill you."
⑥ Drunk up wine - Filled = To be possessed completely -
= Do you want to be filled, really? Controlled by One who
won't tolerate Self, Sin, etc. - Total obedience

1 - Dethrone Self - He can only fill what is empty! Can't
be given - Die to Self - Say "NO" to Self

⑦ Repent, sin
Renounce Self

Two Natures of Believers - Carnal Christ

2 - Enthrone Christ as Lord = Leadership + fulness on TWO sides,
Same experience of Jesus is Lord, we're filled. If filled, because Jesus
is Lord - 1st thing Jesus does when He gets control is fill us.

⑧ "Does not every heart have a master in spirit?" = yield - Rom 12:2
