

Stay Filled w/ THE Spirit - Eph 5:18-21 = You've Got To
fill a cup w/ something! Sprinkle a spiritual wine, a symphony of false
methods, world's way, imitations of love & true gracefulness, completeness
in the Spirit =
Filled = Poured to fill up to cause to abound, to furnish liberally,
to diffuse abundantly - lack Nothing - a complete person -
available to every person
- Tense = Present - continually - deacons - Fuel = a habitual emotion
- tragic sight = Samson = we meet the Philistines & wait not the Spirit is no
longer filling = STAYING FILLED - how Valleys are even higher & Wind
- vs 19, 20, 21 = 3 Partners = How the fullness is manifested
How the fullness is maintained
Note: 1. Each one is continual = to be done habitually
2. Each one is an act of will = Do it! Not me feeling of the
Spirit, but FILLING of spirit = obey & leave rest to God
3. Each one deals w/ a vital relationship -
① to God - worship, ② to circumstances - thanksgiving
③ to others - submission

I. Joyful Worship - vs 19 - Col. 3:16 - ^{Death from PD} Introspection
Introspection
1. Singing ^{Communion} to the Lord - spiritual songs = Ode - Subjective,
unpremeditated - in the spirit - ^{Joy 3:5:10 - small things in the night}
② In your heart - springs from inner life
③ To the Lord = The congregation
④ Instances - Rom 15:9
⑤ Joy - Jimi Hendrix wouldn't stand till they sung hymns
Today at service - never sings - used to sing in choir, etc - but stopped
when fellowship ended
Communication = 1 John 1:3 - our fellowship w/ others & him
2. Sharing w/ one another = This joyful worship is to be
communicated = Doubles your pleasure =
^{Worship because you know He works all things out}

II. Continual Thanksgiving - vs 20 - Paul's most common command.
= acknowledgement of gift received
1. Continual = always
2. Complete = all things
3. Consecrated = ~~wants to~~ ^{Correct = "unto God"} Some
In Name of Jesus
Can't be hypocritical = it's假冒
