

Gal 6:14 - Intro: The basic reactions to Cross & X - Offends
Some people = we sympathize w/ it offend their pseudo-intellectual reasoning;
because it offends their belief that man is basically good - their taste = ~~Hood~~
is offensive to them - a point of embarrassment - ashamed of it.

Indifferent to it

Glory in it = I when Portuguese traders, following trail of
Great explorer Vasco da Gama, settled in Macao on south coast of
China, built a massive Cathedral on hill overlooking harbor.
In front wall, triangular, atop it was great bronze cross - Cross to
ship as soon as first thing saw on top of horizon was that great bronze
Cross, standing serene, sublime, sun dazzling in sea.
Portuguese survived great typhoons = one by one they
hit the church - till finally 300 years ago the church fell -
all except the front wall -

In 1825 Sir John Bowring, governor of Hong Kong visited
Macao - saw the cross, had heard of it - visited the church - The rubble,
debris = towering over it all, serene, sublime, stood that giant bronze cross -
so impressed by the scene wrote his famous hymn.

"In the Cross I glory,
Towering o'er the wrecks of time,
At the light of sacred story
Centered round its head sublime!"

1. The Cross is about the last thing a man would glory in. 1 Cor 1:23
to glory in a cross is a paradox = to be crucified is to be accursed
Gal 3:13 - (get of chair or gallows or scaffold) Paul would allow
② Paul had much he could've gloried in = Phil 3 no competition

2. The Cross is the measure of the man. It gives us the key to their
character -

① Paul had extolled earthly he could boast about Phil 3 = no
confidence in the flesh - so he came finally say = "Glory only
the Cross."

Your Conception of the Cross

3- what cross did Paul glory in = not the cross of the church & religion = we've beautified it - on top of churches, around necks, on walls
or we're wearing crosses but not bearing them.

gsn 53: didn't look like a man

4. He glories in the cross of X = nothing beautiful about that - I identify myself w/ the cross & all it represents -

(1) It is the measure of men's hatred to God = Remind me the world has already told us what it thinks of X ~~Xmas soon~~
- I glory in siding w/ the man the world rejected

(2) It is the measure of God's love of men = when men did his worst, God did His best.

(3) It is the measure of my love for X - John 12:32
- not to gaze in sentimental wonder & current or pity
- not even to bow at its foot & worship -
- But to get in that cross w/ X & share his death - To die w/ him. Gal 2:20

5. // two things happen when you get involved by the cross /

I - As far as you're concerned, the world dies - text

1- The cross separated Paul from the world - The world that always put an end to itself. Paul can never believe in it, take pride in it, nor do homage to it.

The world is stripped of its glory, robbed of its power to charm or control him.

Its smile can't enter him; its frown can't discourage him.

- The world was once to Paul a living, vast & tremendous reality. Now its smile hangs his hopes; its frown his ruin.

Insequently, he was the world's slave & the world was his absolute & cruel Lord -

I. But the Lord has set him free - the world can no longer
Tempt or terrify him. what liberty!!! (3)

The glory of the world is dead, obliterated.

All Paul ever writes the glories gone = they are Dead owing to
Paul

Paul could sing :-

"Jesus, I my cross have taken, all to leave & follow thee;
Despised, despised, forsaken, thou, from hence, my all shall be;
Pursh every fond ambition, all I've sought or hoped or known,
yet how rich is my condition: O heaven are still my own."

"Can't come,
I died last
week."

II. As far as the world is concerned you are Dead = This is a
mutual crucifixion. X has set up his Cross between the believer &
the world & they are separated completely & forever

(1) Saul the Pharisee was a reputable, religious man of the world,
recognized by it, alive to it, taking his place in its affairs -
but that old man has been crucified by X - the
present Paul is in the world's opinion another man altogether.

(2) Paul's ideals & outlooks have now become so spiritual &
other-worldly that the world can ignore him, just as if he
ceased to be.

3 - He would who would go back into that other world, must step
over the cross to do it

(4) you will no longer be looked upon as "Coral", as "KX et."

(5) the world will write you off -
