  - (1) a heavenly nature = 'His Son' E sent, men = He was born, sent
  - sent forth a = His pre-existent we're born, sent
  - 3- His mission = apostle = to

- (2) a Human nature 3- a Holy nature = under the Law no definite article

2- the nature of the Redemption Humble

Curse of Law = Because the Law condemns us, when the Law of our conscience

Those under the Law - subject to its demands

Responsibility to it (1) From the Dominion of the Law

Accountability for it (2) From the Heedfulness of the Law

3:13 = a ~~curse~~ curse. why?

- no one a slave = slavery to religion = a servitude to the Law = always serving it, always accountable to it - but never able to satisfy it

our redemption as sinners / our reception as sons meaning adoption = Roman Law

Salvation is not just a salvage operation

Adoption = not scholarly comment on usage  
but Paul refers to Roman law of adoption —

- 1- Equal status: no preference = just born a  
human
- 2- Eternal security: an adopted son can  
not be disowned —

Sent path = akin to apostle = sent on a  
mission = I sent you on a mission — Troop  
operation = to Emancipate us from our slavery
