Intercession is not ~~praying~~ prayer - it is a position

Identification - feeling along w/ involved - our sin is our ability to minister to people w/ detachment - Having baby w/out travail - willing to be the answer - Don't ask to do something you're not willing to do thru you.

- Pray for one's material well - you be the answer to your own prayer.

- Jesus was: "Father, forgive them..." But he had to die for his blood is the basis of forgiveness

- Lazarus from dead - Jesus was answer to own prayer for his own Resurrection was basis of Lazarus
