

Isa 49: 8-12 - description of D's people as a flock led & fed by a strong shepherd - vs 11 = mountains = indicate struggle, difficulty, obstacles (returning from captivity) - Decryt of Jim by

I - The Possessor of the mountains -

1. my mountains - He is Lord, creation - He is Lord, Providence - He makes our difficult & steep places
1. HE CREATES THEM
2. HE CONTROLS THEM
2. There are mountains which are not His but of our own making ← (BEWARE)
- Our road lies over the mountains

II The Path thru the mountains -

- Some ways open up when we get very close
- He makes a path thru them, - not seen till reached

1. A Thru
2. The mountains become right

III The Pasture on the mountains -

1. "high places" - "let bare heights"
1- "feed in the way" - as they go they find nourishment - a daily supply for daily hunger
2. Bare heights - when times are worst, man may have most of God's presence & blessing

III - PASTURE

1. FEEDS US IN THE WAY = MOVING, OBEYING - AS WE GO, WE FIND NOURISHMENT
2. FEEDS US IN THE WASTE PLACES = "BARE HEIGHTS"
