

Jer. 2: 9-13 Chaffin-wheat  
Intro: vs 12 - "astounded" - Heb - "hair stand on end."  
vs 9 - See if any thing like this - 8th wonder of the world.  
→ Heaven here since beginning, seen everything - Fall, Flood, Cross → but never seen anything like this.

O's people do what heathen would never do -  
Heathen more faithful to false O's than we are to  
True O - Backsliding is a sin which has no  
parallel in the earth.

Ommies, etc more faithful than we -  
United Fund experts more influence, demands & gets  
more loyalty than church.

Why? Simons "I remembered you at Calvary" I knew you in wilderness  
I - Character of People - vs 11, 13 "my people"  
1. intimate term of tenderness & affection - Covenant name,  
people & promise Moses "I knew you in wilderness"  
2. This expression heightens shamefulness of sin  
vs 1 - "you supposed to be a Xian." a contradiction of terms

3. more astounding that O still calls them my people  
Expect - "that people" - My back covenant O remains  
Heb - "not ashamed to be called ear O." "compensating activity"  
Prodigal Son = My Son

II - Character of Sin - vs 11, 13 - "changed value"  
1. Backsliding is an exchange - Principle of life - forsake  
man's mind not idle, not live in vacuum - I don't  
worship O, invent a false O - O thinks Back: what was  
it that took O's place  
2. "Glorious" - value - Jews doing this, man in Dallas who bought Op at 3 mos, turn from O, lessen your worth

2 - Power Two Evils, Heathen commit one - but  
Backslider two - a double sin - what value is it?  
Fictitious  
no sin it could be committed unless heart has moved away from its allegiance.

III - Character of Substitute, vs 13 - Hard to imagine  
man prefer natural water to artesian spring (amazed at taste of water)  
- think can produce something bitter.

1. Crestly Substitute - "Hewed out" of solid rock while  
a few feet away is a flowing fountain! w/out labor & price

2. Prodigal Son - what He sought was in His Father's House.  
Jonah said the Gair - Hosea "Hedge of thorns on path"

2- unsatisfying substitute -  
water not flowing after rain fills with dirt,  
stagnant & stale - tasteless, poisonous  
gr Peter kept bitter

3- worthless substitute -

"Broken & held no water."

(1) in time of drought soon empty. Empty  
when needed most.

in hour of need disappointed.

(2) unable to hold water - unable to  
meet need, answer prayer, comfort  
broken heart.

As disappointing as a broken cistern.
