① Spurgeon: they who dive in the sea of affliction bring up rare pearls.
② Sometimes God must put us in a prison before we will pray - Psalms 130: 1-
"But, the depths have I cried unto thee, O Lord." God puts us in depths so we will cry our way out. ④ - w/ Prayer Never Powerless

I- Prayer Should Be Our Immediate Response: "Call unto me." Why?
1- Because of our situation is perilous to call on God means to summon His aid -
"Calling in this sense constitutes a prayer prompted by a recognized need -
= to call out loudly, "Shout" - Goliath
2- use of this word carries a sense of urgency, emergency & desperation.

③ Jeremiah's fours = famine, pestilence, Jeremiah's own brush w/ death

D "Satan is desperate but we're not."

(A) Because Satan is not ill - Society crumbling, moral walls collapsing, breakups of families, children growing up before one parent & gone from parental guidance for god & D,

- No civilization or society remains static either advancing or decaying

(B) Because things have advanced beyond our ability to handle it = a feeling of helplessness pervades our land.

"we have no might against this great conspiracy that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee -"

surely we have learned that by now = only D can save us - we must Cry unto the Lord.

1- Beyond our Comprehension - D's truths are guarded - ~~as~~ we can enter the fortress of D - That which is plain & obvious to some is an mystery to others - hence their anxiety, worry, galled - James 4 - a simple answer

- 2- Beyond our Circumstances is in us, but not imposed - Jeremiah
- what are your circumstances that make you think you are useless -
 - Can pray & touch the world -
 - w/ Prayer, no child of God should never feel helpless or useless
