

John 12:23-26 - Ø operates according to first law -
Ø takes the obvious & reverses it -
→ Basic principle = "Death must precede life."

1- In vegetable realm unless parent seed dies no fruit. Life is the grain of wheat, but there is a very hard shell on outside - unless outer shell is broken, dies, the life on inside can't get out

2- X's example - giving his life for our life -

3- Discipleship requires the same self-sacrifice Segment Freud favorite

I- If it Die = the greatest hindrance is
X's work is not others but himself - Dying,
the breaking of the outer man is the price
experienced by all who serve Ø -

1- The outer shell is our psyche = physical life,
self life = the Spirit of Ø within us can only
burst forth if we die - or when broken

2- We are dead positionally, not practically -
Baptism is a grave not a bathtub -
we're baptized cause we died, not X.

3- can prove we still living - it wasn't X who
lost his temper, bursted, pride, envies -

II- Bringeth Forth much Fruit = law
of harvest - 1 seed = 3,000 millet seeds.
1- outer shell is our life = release of spirit

III - it abideth alone - sad words

- a grain of wheat is ineffectual & unproductive as long as its preserved -
- "Must I go so empty-handed"
