

- 1- He came to Jesus out of desperation - our needs are servants to bring us to Jesus - it is need that shows me need to live by faith.
- ① His son sick for a long time - v. 46
② His son at point of death - v. 47
- 2- He believed Jesus would have to be present to heal - "come down."
G-matt 8 - The Centurion asked Jesus not to come to his house, but speaking the word was necessary - Jesus marvelled at his faith. Jesus did it differently to correct his misunderstanding = to show that he has org to speak the word.
- 3- Jesus' rebuke - was not to the father specifically but expresses the general attitude of pride -
- 4- the nobleman didn't defend himself or argue - but persisted in the plea - v. 49 - notice the change of the word from son to child - a more affectionate term - indicating he was more concerned of his son than of a sign.
- 5- Jesus did not give him a sign - "He lives" why not? why not go to him? for his sake! for his son's sake! for his son's concern?
- 6- v. 52 - "Your son lives" - not "he will live..." This was a spoken word of power - at that moment he was healed.
- 7- "Go your way" here is a test of faith - if the man returns to plead, no faith - but if, a 2nd sign or additional assurance, he obeys - faith.
- 8- Slave ~~met~~ met him - along the way & confirms our faith
- 9- He believed - an advance in relationship
- 10- His whole house believed.
- 11- He found more than he thought he needed - "Believed a whole house." ~~No~~ A way to increase faith is to exercise faith - start where you are.
- 12- X's rebuke indicates what he thought to be the most important in dealing w/ men - the boy needed healing, but the greater need was that the father be trained to faith.
