

Luke 12:13-21 - A fool: x's wanting y people - hard to accept - we know more he pitied - Rich, a fool,

"take heed" - open eyes - might be a fool & not know it. Tragedy to be deceived about self - a fool can't see - universal appl. to 21

- Seem a good time to think about business Boundaries World, World

I - Can't See Beyond Himself - I, me, my

So many "I's" looks like a picket fence - dropped up in self - small package - no mention of others - grace at meals
no gratitude - Possessions are his - 9/10 of law

no place to store them = barns already built - orphans -
affluence breeds envy instead of satisfaction - if you'd worked on simon's little or more

Doesn't want you to lose riches, just change them - 1/10 Augustine - print goods in camp floor = take them higher

- never enters our mind to do smth for others - axle & wheel revolves around me - Ring in Book

II - Can't See Beyond Things - Difference between Soul & Body = talks to soul - disastrous

concepts, esp: soul can be fed w/ goods - Body poor - spiritual perception: man's brother - R.C. Lee
whose meat in balance - fatal error grows like a tumor at foundation of life

He reckons in many years - goods out last him

III - Can't See Beyond This World - Phil 1:21

O's contrast - O's evaluation & turning of things, this night - require = demanded back - possessions not 9/10 of O's law - taken away - accounts due - while death, barns & building a coffin - But O - no short words - O enters scene at death - These are things that make trouble
