Matt 22:10-14

1 - Grace not only a gift but responsibility.
A man can't go on living the life he
lived before he met X.

— Door open not that the sinner may
come & remain a sinner but sinner may
come & become a saint.

2 - The way a man comes to anything
demonstrates the spirit in which
he comes.

— a matter of respect vs tidy up for
friends — not show. Esteem of friend.

— Parable has nothing to do with clothes
we wear to church, but spirit in which
we come.

Too often come with no preparation
at all.

Two Sons = Jesus asked them to pass judgment & they condemned themselves. Bitter & Two Birds

Matt 21:28-32 - Jewish leaders - said worded I didn't

Publication's sinners = said wouldn't eat did Jesus isn't praising anyone - bitter & me bad.

two classes of People

- 1 - Profession bitter than practice
- 2 - Practice bitter than profession

→ Foolish promises can never take place of performance

Joy & Judgment

Matt 22:1-10 - oriental practice -

2 meanings:

1 - local - accusation of Jews - ages ago they had been invited - rejected Jesus.
→ Consequences of refusal + terrible - Desst. of Jer. in 70 AD

→ If Jews had accepted X, wouldn't be rebellious + been destroyed.

2. wider meaning

① O's invitation one to joy

② Things which make men day to invitation are not bad in themselves.

- easy for a man to be so busy with time, he forgets eternity. Second best option isn't best.

③ not so much how we'll be punished but to see what we miss, realization of precious things we missed.
