① Fish by loaves ② Triumphant ride into Jeru = a coat tied ③ Last Supper = met a man bearing a picture of water - follow him ④ Nathanael - "I saw thee under the fig tree."
- a life changing encounter = taking words & symbols & making them into O's somebody
2. Jesus makes Himself available to man - "What wilt thou I should do for thee?" ① placed key to Heaven's Treasure house into the beggar's hand.
② & Surprised question = Surely a blind man would want his sight? - Surprised at some man's evaluation of their needs.
- Forced self-examination Be specific
- Vocalize his consciousness of sin = an admitting need.

II - There always something standing in way: "They rebuked him - keep quiet" - no one ever came to Jesus w/out someone trying to stop him.
- Threw off cloak - have to abandon something - how strong is your desire?

III - Passing = Jesus on way to Jerusalem to die - His first chance was his last chance =
① Pharaoh - when? "Tomorrow" too late, Present
② He stopped for a Beggar, He'll stop for you! minute
