

Micah 6:6-8

"Justly" the capacity to make a basic + actual distinction between good + evil" → expresses a relationship, regulates the relationships in a specific society

loves - to love, cleave to, run after -
- pragmatic
- includes a conscious act in behalf of the person loved - love expressed in activity - mercy - kindness

mercy = covenant faithfulness + grace

Mercy - play a great part in administration of justice - The accused must seek to arouse the mercy of the judge - But here, the judge arouses his own mercy -

- mercy - arises out of a mutual relationship. It is the attitude which ~~both~~ the one expects of the other in this relationship, + to which he is pledged in relation to him.

Mercy - not primarily a disposition, but a helpful act ~~or~~ corresponding to relationship of trust + faithfulness
