I - Forget His Works - lost the impression the
works made on them
They made haste -

Isa 28:16 - He that behineth does not make
haste - the expectations antecipated O's promise -
The works were undeniable evidence of O's
wisdom, power, goodness

II - Impatience - Didn't wait for O to unfold
his plan in his own time & by his own method

III - Self-willed

IV - Challenged O = on narrow track &
O will deliver - put O on ~~the~~ spot - Force
O's hand, Force his blessing

Danger Signs = Discontent murmuring
Dissatisfied

Saul - 1 Sam 13 - Saul was unwilling
to fight w/out seeing O but was unwilling
to wait for O's time. Something had to be
done; the hour for action had arrived,
