

Phil 2:12-16. Intro Meadland = stone in quarry. "why do you want it?" there's an angel in there, I want to release him!" why do you want to die on cross for this fellow - "same answer" - this is the word Paul uses

- Paul's man work for = (1) already saved
(2) Sal is a work of Θ for man, not man of Θ .

fear & trembling = attitude = a wholesome caution - self-destruct = shows the seriousness of the task = lest chip the stone

vs 13 = divine enablement = encouragement - Θ works, not w/ by, behind but IN you - energizes you &

TO will & TO do =

Sm of Θ = become what you profess to be & ought to be

- Θ makes us willing, desiring to do Θ 's will
- & Θ provides necessary power to do it.

w/out Rebuke = harmless; sacrificial word

vs 16 = real test of Salvation

Murmuring = moral rebellion

disputing = doubting = intellectual rebellion

Blameless = w/out reproach = no ping of criticism

Harmless: Pure, unmixed = are what you appear to be
