delights in His commandments -

not just keeps them but delights in them

of 11:11 - same things said & are
said by those who fear Him. You
become like Me & you boast.

- Being stable in times of bad news isn't a matter
of quoting a verse (emergency kit) or going thru
a formula - it is the result of a character
grounded in devotion + conforming to the will of D.

- delight = not a stoic obedience but an inward
delight
