- I - It is maintained by God - "I will assemble, assemble
the remnant - it is a Work of God
 his wrath, his grace - God never without a witness - keeps purifying
 in people - Church, divine institution - God does it
 "I will gather them" 1 Kings 19

- II - It is a minority - "Remnant" - narrowing figure

- V - It is the messiah vs 13 - Isa -
 Branch -
 Def. of Remnant - 1 - alone ② Survival Judgment
 ③ Transmits life to others.

I- It Lives In The Messiah - vs13 - "The Remnant."

1- Remnant referred to as a new shoot bursting forth with new life from an old trunk - Isa 6:13 - messiah also compared to a new Branch - (Isa 4:2; 11:1; 53:2; Psa 80:15ff)

2. The Central & life-giving element in the remnant is the messiah. The Remnant can only exist in so far as it revolves around Him (text), in so far as all its other members are grafted on to Him & share His life - (Jer. 23:36)
True also for The Church in N.T.

① alone = narrowed, deserted by friends

② Survived Judgment, Death - ~~He who~~ is the truly righteous Remnant "survived" the ultimate catastrophe, "death" by resurrection. In that survival life was maintained & indeed made available by the act of ^{(2) Transmits Life} Christ. They who participate in His new life are the New Israel, The remnant according to the election of grace - (Rom 11:5)

3- Ezek's Chr - Born again -

4- The reason for the choice of 12 disciples was to claim by symbolic action, that X was leader of New Remnant. X thought of Church as The Remnant that should inherit the mission of Israel.

IV - Marked -

1. By its Separation ^{from world} - vs 12 - "put together - as flock in the midst of their fold." gathered into one place

(1) distinct characteristic, different from others. — Remnant characterized by a new loyalty to God.

(2) Amos - Remnant not spared by accident but because by its reputation it is returning to a faithfulness that makes it the heir by the promises (Amos 5:15)

(3) The call to choose between God & other claimants comes at about the same time as the idea of the faithful Remnant, in days of Elijah. The prophet's call to Israel always to the same time as the revelation to the prophet that there are 7,000 left in Israel who've not bowed knee to Baal.

(4) In N.T. saint rarely is singular - saints - together

(5) United into one flock -

2. By its Sacrifice - "sheep of Bozrah." —

(1) Bozrah, capital city of Edom, arch enemy of Israel - in midst of enemies - Amos prophesies its destruction - 1:12; 9:12

(2) Isa 34:6 - massacre which God will inflict upon Edom & Bozrah is described as a sacrificial slaugthering, lambs - etc.

(3) In midst of enemies, yet "in a fold" - protected, denoting how believers should be fenced within the Church, as by a strong wall, against which the powers of darkness should not prevail. — over →

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Bozrah destroyed - but Remnant, sheep
in a fold - protected, escape the
judgment of world. "in present & mind
shameless,"

③ Amr describes it as a torn, bruised remnant
Amos 3:12 ; 4:11

④ In Ezek. 11:14-20, prophet rebuked the
self-satisfied satisfaction of those who
remained in Palestine, & announced that
the happy future to lay with the exiles, to
whom a new heart would be given.

⑤ The spiritual kernel had not enjoyed any
miraculous deliverance from the calamities
which overwhelmed the Kingdom. They suffered
more acutely than the rest of the people.

Part of Jeremiah's life.

→ Exile was a death, self-sacrifice - only then
this could you be part of God's people.

Part of Jesus, early Church.

⑥ The Remnant saves by self-sacrifice
& suffering.

II- A minority - "ns 12 - "a remnant."

- 1- Bible fully surprises - would expect it to be tribe of Joseph, most remarkable; all Jacob's Sons. Or Ephraim, the most populous. - but it is Judah.
 - 2- God's method: always thru the few - Elijah "alone" on mt Carmel, Jesus & 12 - finally Jesus only.
 3. nor is it those who remain in Promised Land, but the first emigrants, the unfortunate, the poor - Matt 4:6, 7
Isa 16:14 - Isa 10, 21, 22
- to narrowing process -
- (1) Relation between God & His people simple — what is required of them is exclusive loyalty to Him & obedience to His will as revealed in the Law & prophets — So long as the requirements of God aren't made too exacting, this works well: so long as the standard is not pitched too high, the majority of people can attain to it.
- But as the standard of loyalty & obedience is raised, the number of people who attain it decreases. It ceases to be an ideal for the nation & becomes an ideal for an elect few within the nation.
- (2) Thoroughgoing observance of the Law, etc was a task for which not many would have the inclination —
- (3) The faithful community ought to include the whole of Israel, but Israel as a whole comes short of the standard.
- (4) From first humanity to Noah; from this second humanity to a family again, that of Abraham; from nation of Abraham's descendants to smaller groups.
- (5) Moses only child saved from slaying children - when God would have destroyed people because of idolatry, Moses spared - wilderness generation dies, but Caleb & Joshua alone & next generation enter Promised Land. Eli, priestly community who took care of Ark (God's presence) destroyed - Samuel alone survives.

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Mimicry = narrowing process

⑥ Compare to a line, base is exodus from Egypt - To becomes more narrowed thru centuries to an ever decreasing Remnant, until its apex is constituted by the sole "remaining" One Jesus ^x, who "remains" triumphantly thru the death, cross & resurrection.

→ Exodus was beginning of People of God - Cross beginning of Church.

→ the infant Jesus alone (as Moses) escapes the slaughter of the innocents; the circle of His followers progressively diminishes, then He is abandoned in turn by several of His disciples, till He remains alone & desolate hanging on a cross.
(His cross is pattern & prophecy of Church)

⑦ God always having to start again - after flood with Noah, Abraham, Jacob, Judah (Psa 78:67ff), with children of captivity (Ezra 4:1-3, 8ff), then w/ Son of Man (Dan. 7:13) who represents 'Saints of the Most High' (Dan. 7:18, 29). This Remnant, Son of man gets narrowed down at last to Lord Jesus Himself alone, & then as from Pentecost begins to grow like the grain of mustard seed (Jer. 18:4)

The tough demands of Jesus - How He was always sifting, dwindling, narrowing -

III Means of Salvation - no 12 - "noise" multiplies - noise made by densely packed & numerous flock. maintains O's witness in world -

- 1- True Remnant The old Israel prolongs its life & by its means the life of people safeguarded - sanctifies the life, & promises once made to the whole are focused within it.
- 2- Joel 2:32 - It is a bridge between the two moments (Past & present) in history of O's people. The Remnant exists for sake of the eschatological community to come.

Numbers 14:12 - Ex 32:10 - Isa 60: 1, 22 -

(1) The life of the ancient people which in a hidden form has been transmitted to the Remnant is one day to blossom forth in the people of the future - Life of Jesus has been transmitted to us - Noah spout - Moses waned have been = Ex. 32:10

(2) Important function of Remnant: it is the instrument of grace of O toward others, the narrow channel thru which O mediates His grace - O's grace flows thru us to others. Sol. comes from O, but thru man (Jesus) ~~Jesus~~ Jesus was Remnant & we are the Remnant. Very few (only a remnant) in Church who transmit life to those dead in sin.

Ex 18:26 - Jer 5:1

3- Temptation existed in Israel & in us - Keeping jealously the monopoly of spiritual life - Then it has ceased to be an organ for the transmission of Divine life; its principle is self-conservation. Hence arise its characteristics - pride, egotism, & lack of brotherly love - Pharisees - Not just Saved, but Saving

(1) One danger, the Remnant idea is that the nucleus should build walls round itself & be satisfied. The Remnant is not a safe enclave, but a cell, seed of future growth, restless short that must blossom forth & produce fruit - not functioning place but launching pad -

(2) The Church is not an end in itself, but a means to an end. Must always be pushing down its walls &

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- working out; its purpose is to bring "a remnant to the Gentiles," & O's sol. to the end of the earth.
- (3) when the people [↑] ceases in any age to do this - O starts again with another Remnant.
- 4- It is thru the faithful Remnant that again & again O has to fix his hope for the future - it is thru them that He carries on His saving work - salty earth which preserves the whole - (I Cor. 10:13 says if Xian woman in home, all are sanctified.)
- The faithfulness of the few can save the rest - Gen 18:32
- 5- Remnant survives not only that its members may live, but that thru them, & in them the life of the people to whom they belong can go on. — Remnant is a "depository" of life ^{Subject} O.
- 6- Service, not Sol., pumping Israel's election - Israel & Edom - Jacob & Esau - First has justified that choice.
7. In Isa 66:18-20 the Remnant is first saved, then sent on a mission to the world.

2- & has always kept for Himself a People - never
without a witness - preserved - 7,000 → 1 Kings 19:18
no matter how wayward people may be, there will still be 7,000 in Israel.
3- it is a work of D - Grace, mercy mercy - Isa 1:9; Amos 9:11-5
Church Divine institution or couldn't have survived the
way we've run it! Anything else would've been dead -
→ they survive not because of resourcefulness or strength of
the few, which enables them to escape the disaster
by their own initiative. The fact that some survive
is a miraculous event - which D alone is the author
Ezek 36:22 - a spared People
→ The important factor, not size or who - but that it still
exists.

→ Remnant is what is left when judgment is over -

Maintained by D's Grace & by His wrath
wrath - In O.T. it nearly always springs from some
catastrophe which has brought destruction on the people
as a whole. Suggests at once the anger of D against the
sin of His people. The smaller the remnant the
greater the destruction, & the more serious the sin. What
remains therefore stands as a witness to the wrath of D.
def = survivor from disaster - escaped Remnant.

D is always having to start over again.

Remnant not spared by accident, but saved by D in His
own purposes.
