

Rev 5 - Intro: No man can control his own destiny - Name things turned out as you planned, intended - that's the point here - The Seven-Sealed book - Book of Human Destiny - Sealed = a profound secret. No one worthy - moral worth = because of our sin - we forfeited right -

Only one worthy - to 7 - The destiny of man is in the hands of Jesus X. No one worthy = sin, make a mess of it.

Only one able to open the book - only one able to make life with living, only one able to solve problem, give meaning & purpose to life - in X that life finds its purpose - It is me like a car w/out a steering wheel, keep pressing on the gas.

It is worthy to control your life
It is saying that Jesus is the only one worthy to control your life, guide it

as a - Thou art worthy to take man's destiny & control it for: The reason why should I give all this to Jesus vs 1, 2

I don't have the right to take my life into my own hands

I. Because of the sacrifice he made - vs 9
Man by his sin involved himself in choos: death - X by his sacrifice involved himself in our death.
1- Sacrifice primarily for O = redeemed us to O - not for man's benefit, but just for O's - O ~~ought~~ ought to benefit from our redemption.

J. Because of what he made of himself as a
1- our sacrifice = violent death - vs 6 slain: w/ my blood butchered

Total = he was tempted to take easy way - he went all the way for us

2- to O = for O's benefit - not ours
3- for everyone - universal - means everyone has the same need - same solution

Because of what made of himself us - vs 10
1- Kings =
2- Priest
3- Ruler = victorious living
