

The meaning of Sanctification
Rom 6:1-7:6

Intro (1) Just. calls us righteous - sanctification makes us righteous -

(2) Sanc. is the growth & development of the new life that is imparted in regeneration.
vs 14 - meaning: "Sin shall not have dominion over you." - O's purpose

(3) In Just. O breaks the power of sin to condemn us, in sanc. O breaks the power of sin to control us

(4) not sinless perfection = caused by an inadequate view of sin = not a series of acts to be stopped or a tooth to be pulled - but an inborn drive which must be counteracted by a superior force - the Holy Spirit -
inadequate view of sancet = as if the negative, or ceasing to sin were the whole
