- The work of X brings blessing
- our blessing comes from a curse - we go from tree

I. From X This Salvation is made available

1. From the death of the Cross = curse makes
death - became a curse for us - make our
place

2. From the disgrace of the Cross = a curse =
outside the law - "deserving the shame"
a scandal

- Prophets curse + Jesus cried "accused"

II - In X This Salvation Is Made Actual -

does this mean everyone saved? No - it is not
in X = must be appropriated by every person.
vv23-29 = analysis, curse into blessing.

1. Lead To X = By the Law = purpose of Law = convinces
us we need to be saved vv24 = God's custody, handed over to faith

2. Faith In X = resting in, resting in X - appropriates
this work

3. Baptised Into X - picture of death + resurrection ending
one relationship + starting a new one. union w/ - immersed
into it - inseparable from

4. Put on X - putting on clothing = discard old lifestyle + dress in new
Identify our appearance = clothes of X - we become our environment

5. One In X = purity, oneness = all walls down = destination exists
but don't matter = no longer evaluate people on basis of race, social or sex

6. Belong To X = constructing X indicates an intimate, personal
relationship = we are His possession = He assumes full responsibility
He shows me inheritance
