

Titus 2:1-10 - Ven 10-1 - adorn: to arrange, set in order - used of
arranging jewels so as to best set off their full beauty - we
are to take teachings of Gospel & arrange them in such a way
as to set off full beauty

I ability to Adorn Gospel = we can actually make
Gospel more beautiful -

- 1- show our estimate of it - don't carpet garage (farm)
- 2- we advertise it, make it more attractive - picture frame,
king in royal robes - more desirable to the observer
- John 3:16; Golden Rule - Beautiful to say "if you love me,
keep my commandments - "more beautiful to see it."

II - the activity by which we adorn the Gospel
"in all things" - not preaching, etc. The polish of a good life

- 1- the small details of everyday life - old men & women, warts
shows ① a small ~~path~~ log falls to ground by some power
as giant oak - if fail in small things, fail in big things.

A Religion that could produce honest slaves?

- 2- The Gospel is supposed to make you a better worker,
wife, student, employee **ask any employer, teacher, parent**

① St. Francis of Assisi = walked thru valleys = every step we
took was a sermon. ② youth; drabky parents, etc, men sing in
choir, no confidence in testimony = Employee, mother,
SPORTS

- 3- Why Single out Slaves = these kids were peculiar to this class -
- they were honest, most difficult conditions - no one expected them to
be honest, work hard, etc - ① in like manner = all of us here,
in our class we belong, certain evils natural to our position.

② Pize about not level - if we do business same way, take same short
cuts, we aren't honoring the Gospel.

St. Daniel in Captivity = "There is a people here whose
laws are different from all the people that be on the earth."

③ Law = just consideration = Beautify the Gospel

The alternative to adorning Gospel

is 5 - either beautifying or blaspheming ^{denying, Gospel} _{reproach}
Decorating or discarding
