

Two safeguards against being deceived

I - the apostolic word -

Apostolic = "you have from the beginning" & the traditional message & Be suspicious of any teaching that ~~abandons~~ contradicts the traditional teaching of the church & Part of O's plan = to preserve the truth by passing it on.

1 - A Familiar message 1 Tim 3:14f

- 2 - Faithful messengers 3:14f

This is an objective safeguard 1 Cor 11:3, 4

"by skin print" a child turns when an apple falls; He may teach the truth but believe it because another ~~says so~~, ^{says so, not him}

II - The Anointing Spirit - A subjective

experience - it is the spirit that enables us to grasp the word & it is the word that the spirit teaches

Note how John combines these two - not just the spirit alone - Catherine Marshall

Quinto = "Spirit revelation not limited to O's N.T Canon."

- Subjective: believing your child has done something wrong - can't be objective because personally involved, interested.
