Burden of prayer → walk worthy - conform to a
 standard - correspond to what God demands of us.
 'a religion of conduct' ^{my doctrine fits} into the leather stand for
 guns -

I - Foundations of worthy life - The works which 'stir'
 seem great are nothing if not God's will - to
 (2) 1 knowledge - obedience to God's will
 (3) Filled - idea of completeness - prevaling out their
 thoughts - no room for anything else - faith -
 most miserable place = out of God's will.
 → all perfection consists in doing God's will
 a desire to secure His approval
 Reason for prayer = need their
 when they are bowed

II - Goal of worthy life - "unto all pleasing."
 So as to please God in all ways - everything -
 1 - not to be limited by our duty, but to please Him our
highest desire.
 2 - all = Everyone pleases the Lord in some way - but
 we → please Him in all ways.
 3 - man have thrown away life for few words of praise -
 (Palate)

III - Ingredients of a worthy life -
 1 - Fruit-bearing - figure of a tree - judged by
our fruit - barrenness is deadness.
 (1) not in one form - one kind of fruit is no
compensation - "every good work." ←
 (2) The only true fruit is goodness -
no exception.
 (3) Increasing in knowledge of God - Progress
 (1) is the law of Christian life. - Increasing: not
 stagnant or static - waters become poisonous
 when stagnant. So do Christians.
