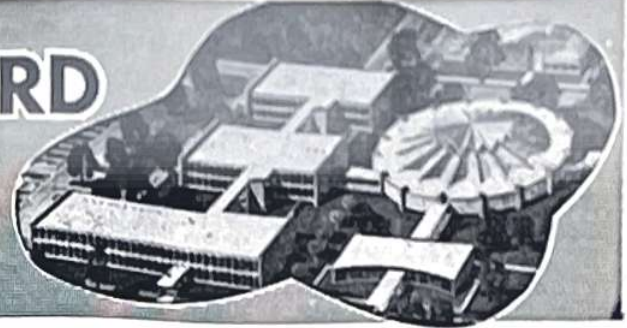

A CHALLENGE FROM THE LORD TO MBBC

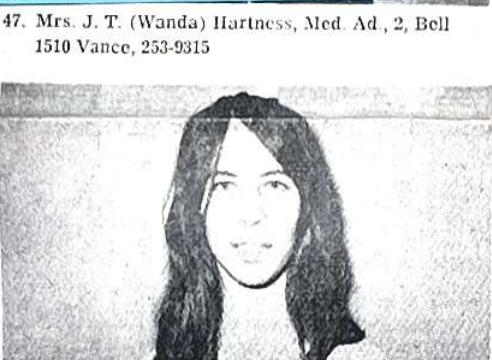
