I want you to pray for this class. The possibilities are staggering. The Spirit confirmed in my own heart last Friday that He's going to use this class in a special way.

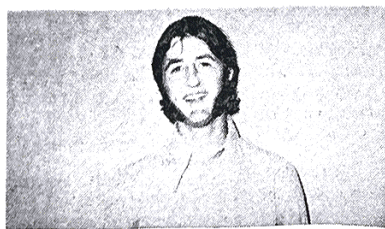

CHRISTIAN LIFE CONFERENCE BEGINS THIS SUNDAY MORNING

John Hunter returns to MBBC this Sunday for a six-day conference on the Christian Life. Dr. Hunter comes from Kendal, Westmoreland, England. He is the field representative in the work of "The Torchbearers," a former principal of a state school in England and a war-time officer in the British Royal Air Force.

He is married and the father of four children. His wife is associated with the work at Capernwray. The Hunters' two sons are with the Sudan Interior Mission doing pioneer work in Southern Ethiopia. Dr. Hunter teaches and preaches the Word of God in conferences, churches, colleges, and other institutions throughout Great Britain and Europe. He also conducted a thirty-three week speaking tour around the world including the Far East, Australia, New Zealand, India and Africa.

A best-sellin' author on the Christian Life, Dr. Hunter has written KNOWING GOD'S SECRETS, LIMITING GOD, LIVING THE CHRIST-FILLED LIFE and others.

Since January of 1969 when Dr. Hunter was with us for the first time, I've looked forward to this time. We are extremely blessed to have this unique Man of God with us these six days. Don't miss a single service.
