THE SOUND SYSTEM

One requirement the pastor and staff made to the architects was that the Worship Center would have a first class sound system. Joiner, Pelton, and Rose, an acoustical engineering firm in Dallas, was contracted for consultation.

The system consists of: several large high quality speakers suspended from the ceiling over the pulpit area; 15 microphone inputs in the choir loft and pulpit area; 10 microphone inputs in the congregational area; balcony sound booth control of all lighting, sound, air and heating; tape facilities; and proper acoustical treatment of ceiling, walls and floor for good sound. The firm also gave consultation on treatment of the choir rehearsal room.

Attention Mothers Day Out

Because of State Welfare regulations, the following changes must be made in our Thursday schedule. Beginning November 8:
