Everywhere I go among our people there is a spirit of uncontrollable rejoicing over what God is

(2) God has greater blessings in store. "You ain't seen nothing yet." God is merely getting us ready for greater displays of his glory.
(3) The key is "Praise to the Lord." In every case where our people have entered into this attitude of the Lordship of Christ, their immediate reaction has been "praise" and "thanksgiving". Their prayer life undergoes a revolution —it is mostly praising God for His goodness. God for His goodness.

(4) Don't talk about the church, Talk about Jesus. It isn't our church or the denominational program that's bringing this about, it is God. When people ask you about it, don't tell them how great our church is. Tell them what Christ has done in your life. The only thing the Holy Spirit is interested in is GLORI-FYING JESUS

(5) Don't try to help the revival along — don't try to force it or make it happen. Just get out of the way and let God do what He pleases.

(6) Let the revival overflow the banks of your life

and spill on others. Nothing kills this kind of revival quicker than the attitude that God is blessing us just to be blessing us. That's the big mistake Israel made. Every day make yourself available to God and He will use you to witness to others of Christ. You'll find you won't have to go looking for people to witness to:
