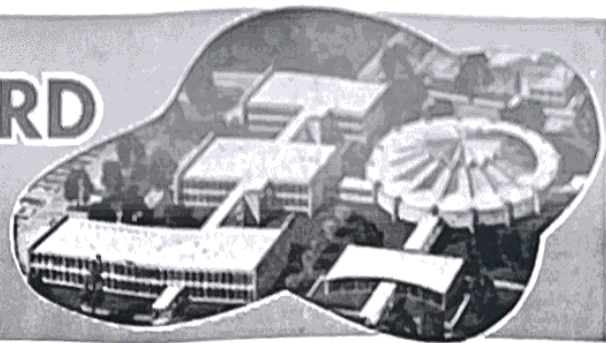

Nominating Committee has prepared a Sunday School Workers' Covenant for our 1970-71 teachers and officers.

This covenant is one of many efforts to be introduced to improve the effectiveness of our teaching and teaching ministries. The covenant is as follows:

SUNDAY SCHOOL WORKERS COVENANT
In an effort to upgrade the quality of teaching of God's Word in our Sunday School, MBBC's Nominating Committee is asking that all Sunday School workers commit themselves to the following covenant:

I. "I WILL RECOGNIZE THE GLORY OF MY TASK."

Who has greater opportunity to sway the future than a God-called, Spirit-filled Sunday School teacher. A dedicated Sunday School teacher should build dreams of the idea teacher, and then seek to be that teacher.

II. "I WILL BE POSITIVELY EVANGELISTIC."

All teachers, regardless of the age of their class, should be vitally interested in the salvation of the lost. I will lead my class in concern over the lost, and train them to be witnesses and soul-winners.

III. "I WILL BE WELL TRAINED"

A teacher should neither be content with his present achievements nor satisfied to do his job year after year the same way. I will prepare myself through personal study and other available opportunities.

IV. "I WILL SUPPORT THROUGH PERSONAL PERSONAL PARTICIPATION THE VISITATION PROGRAM OF OUR CHURCH TO THE BEST OF MY ABILITY."

In order to lead my pupils in their spiritual development, I must know my pupils well enough to know of their deepest needs. Do I have an up-to-date Prospect file? Every person living in this community that falls into my age group is primarily my responsibility, and primarily no one else's.

V. "I WILL SUPPORT BY MY ATTENDANCE THE WEEKLY TEACHERS AND OFFICERS MEETING UNLESS PROVIDENTIALLY HINDERED."

Would you ever consider a doctor to be too well trained when he is attempting to save your life? Or a lawyer too brilliant when he is defending your life! A group study of the Bible, a group approach to organization and planning, and group fellowship in prayer can only be accomplished when all teachers attend Teachers meetings regularly.

VI. "I WILL LEAD MY CLASS TO WORSHIP SERVICES AND PRAYER MEETINGS."

I must magnify group worship and prayer by being faithful in my attendance to our worship services and prayer meetings.

VII. "I WILL TRY TO BE AN EXAMPLE BEFORE MY PUPILS."

Do you suppose that more is caught from a teacher than is taught by him? Most class members need to SEE a Christian life rather than hear about one.

VIII. "I WILL SUPPORT THE TOTAL PROGRAM OF THE CHURCH."

My cooperation is necessary with regards to special emphases such as revivals, missions, and stewardship campaigns.
