

## I - Communion of the Saviors Life Thru us

- 1- vs 10, 11 - the context shows that whatever the cost, the life of X must be redeemed thru our body.
  - 2- Rom 5:10 - "saved by his life"
  - 3- Vine + the branches
- Breaking the outer man to get thru to the Spirit.
  - Can't smell the perfume - just see the alabaster box

## II - Crucifixion of the Self Life Within us

- vs 10, 11, 12 = Law of the spiritual harvest is life out of death. If there is to be a continual manifestation of X's life, there must be a constant crucifixion of flesh.
- a way to every demand that the flesh makes for recognition, approval, or vindication - John 7:24, 25
  - Jesus in Isa 53 - cross E/32:31 (Paul) Rom. 9:1
  - Col 1: "fill up the sufferings of X" Text = 2 Cor 4:10-12
  - in all situations & in every circumstance, there is death to my likes & wishes, ideas, ambitions - then there is the communion of the life of Jesus.

"all thru life I see a cross -  
when sons & girls of their breath  
there is no gain except by loss  
there is no life except by death"

- Release of the Spirit = alabaster box = if I take voluntary death to the normal advantages in the flesh, comfort, loved ones, material advancement - I have the right to claim & receive the harvest of Spirit
- when someone is saved, it's because someone has died  
Peter + Cornelius = he died to prejudice & pre-conceived notions
